



**LOWER ZAMBEZI & SOUTH LUANGWA SAFARI SPECIAL – 8 nights**

Day 1 Arrive in Lusaka where you will be met and transferred to check in for your internal flight which will be on a light aircraft, possibly as small as a 4 seater plane.\*

Lusaka – Royal

You will be met at the airstrip and transferred by safari vehicle to camp.

Day 1-5 **CHONGWE RIVER CAMP – 4 nights**

Chongwe river camp is also set in a wonderful position on the banks of a pretty tributary of the mighty Zambezi River next to the Lower Zambezi National Park.



The tents are all under thatch and have a private verandah overlooking the river, ideal for contemplation of Africa’s beauty...

The main area at Chongwe is a wonderful tent built around an

ancient Winterthorn tree, with a bar and reading area, then all other dining is al fresco, taking advantage of the stunning views and setting. Everyone dines together at this camp, with a chance to chat with your guide over the meal and plan the next day’s activities. Game activities are



generally based on approximately 4 hours duration. The morning activities usually set out after breakfast. The afternoon activities usually set out following afternoon tea.

River activities need to be concluded by dusk. Longer activities with packed lunches can be organized in advance for guests on game drives & fishing trips.



Open safari vehicles are used for game drives. All

game walks are accompanied by an armed ZAWA Scout Basic regular and fly

fishing tackle is available for our guests use. Refreshments are provided on all activities and Sundowners offered to take advantage of the African sunsets. The safari package includes accommodation in a classic tent with all meals, activities and boating, National Park Entry fees,



conservation levies, laundry, local drinks (excluding premium wines and imported spirits) and transfers included.

Day 5

You will be transferred by boat up river to the Park where you will meet a safari vehicle which will transfer you to the airstrip for the flight directly to Mfuwe.

**FLATDOGS CAMP – 4 nights**



The luxury ensuite safari tents offer you a back to nature taste of the wild, with large windows

all around the tent so you can see and hear the animals feeding in camp as well as the hippopotamus honking to each other in the river in front of you!

The tents are spacious with king or twin beds, large mosquito net, electric lights and plug sockets for re-charging batteries (UK style plug sockets). There is also a room safe and tea and coffee-making facilities. The luxury tents have semi open ensuite bathrooms with hot shower, WC and basin.



Time to settle into camp and have some lunch, before your first afternoon safari into the South Luangwa National Park. In the afternoons, we tend to meet for tea at 15h30, then head into the park at 16h00, ready to explore this magnificent wilderness. Our guides take huge pride in their work, being able to identify numerous alarm calls and to track animals and try to anticipate their next move so as to

position you for the best sightings.



As the sun starts to dip towards the horizon, your guide will find a good spot to stop so you can stretch your legs and watch the sun set with a cold drink in hand... Then, once it's nearly dark, you will carry on game-viewing with a spotlight,

searching for some of our interesting nocturnal residents, like the leopard, lion, porcupine, civet, genet, owls and hyaena.

You will return to camp at around 20h00 in time for dinner and to relive your sightings with us!

In the mornings, we offer you an early breakfast of toast and cereal, tea and coffee at 05h30 before you head out at 06h00 on a morning game drive, exploring the park, taking the sightings as they come, with your guide detailing all you are seeing and adding interesting observations
